- 1. Photographs may be colour or black and white.
- 2. Only digital entries will be accepted.
- Photographs must have been taken in Orpington (BR6 or BR5 post code) but may have been taken at any point in time.
- 4. All entries must include a completed entry form.
- 5. Photos must have been taken by the person named on the entry form.
- 6. Photographers will retain copyright for their work. However, Orpington 1st have the right to use images in the Orpington 2023 Calendar, in print and press for promotional purposes and to publish them on the website/social media channels.
- 7. Photos should be landscape (images in the calendar will have an aspect ratio of approx. 15:9. Photos may be cropped slightly to fit format).
- 8. Wherever possible, photographers will be credited appropriately.
- 9. All images should be in jpeg format to the highest resolution possible.
- 10. Photographers may enter as many images as they wish.
- 11. All judges' decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 12. Closing date for entries is 5pm 30 September 2022.
- All entrants must ensure they have obtained the necessary permissions prior to entering the competition, particularly if the photos include human subjects.
- 14. If the winning entrant is under the age of 18, the prize must be collected by their parent or guardian.
- 15. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of the rules.
